

Legislative Chairpersons Eileen & Robin (School Nurse Specific) (2018-2019)

Bill: S1126 AcAaA (2R) P.L. 2019, c. 250
Summary: Requires public school districts to provide instruction on "New Jersey Safe Haven Infant Protection Act" as part of New Jersey Student Learning Standards.

Bill: S1735 P.L. 2019, c. 242
Summary: Requires certain public facilities and offices to provide on-site lactation room; DOH to provide information about lactation room availability; and DOE to provide information on lactation policies in schools.

Bill: A5021 AcAsa (2R) P.L. 2019, c. 237
Summary: Requires Medicaid coverage for group prenatal care services under certain circumstances.

Bill: S2861 SCS (SCS) P.L. 2019, c. 222
Summary: Requires health curriculum for public school students in grades kindergarten through 12 to include instruction on mental health.

Bill: A1428 AcAsa (2R) P.L. 2019, c. 189
Summary: Requires Department of Education to develop guidelines for school districts concerning child trafficking awareness and prevention.

Bill: A769 AcAsaSaSa (4R) P.L. 2019, c. 185
Summary: Requires school districts to incorporate age-appropriate sexual abuse and assault awareness and prevention education in grades preschool through 12 as part of New Jersey Student Learning Standards in Comprehensive Health and Physical Education.

Bill: S2489 P.L. 2019, c. 178
Summary: Requires board of education to post information about child abuse hotline in each school.

Bill: S954 ScSSca (SCS/1R) P.L. 2019, c. 172
Summary: Enters New Jersey in enhanced multistate Nurse Licensure Compact.

Bill: S858 Sa (1R) P.L. 2019, c. 171
Summary: Requires teachers of health and physical education in grades kindergarten through six in public schools to possess appropriate endorsement to instructional certificate.

Bill: A4799 AcA (1R) P.L. 2019, c. 118
Summary: Permits self-administration of hydrocortisone sodium succinate by students for adrenal insufficiency and requires that school districts and nonpublic schools establish policy for emergency administration of medication.

Bill: S2711 AcAaAaA (3R) P.L. 2019, c. 109
Summary: Mandates child abuse and sexual abuse training for all candidates for teaching certification.

Bill: S875 Sca (1R) P.L. 2019, c. 103
Summary: Establishes the "Sexual Assault Victim's Bill of Rights."

Bill: A4342 Aca w/GR (2R) P.L. 2019, c. 57
Summary: Requires public school student to carry identification card at school-sponsored, off-campus activities and requires principal to keep list of students on school buses used for school-sponsored activities in case of emergencies.

Bill: S2714 P.L. 2019, c. 46
Summary: Requires school districts to notify State Board of Examiners when teaching staff member fails to report child abuse for determination of revocation or suspension of certificate.

Bill: A764 AcasScasca w/GR (4R) P.L. 2019, c. 33
Summary: "Alyssa's Law", requires public school buildings to be equipped with panic alarm linked to local law enforcement.

Bill: A2190 P.L. 2019, c. 16
Summary: Requires school districts to incorporate instruction in grades six through 12 on law and meaning of consent for physical contact and sexual activity as part of Student Learning Standards in Comprehensive Health and Physical Education.

Bill: A542 Aca (1R) P.L. 2018, c. 106
Summary: Requires certain schools to maintain supply of opioid antidotes and permits emergency administration of opioid antidote by school nurse or trained employee.

Bill: A2189 Sa (1R) P.L. 2018, c. 80
Summary: Requires school districts to include instruction on consequences of distributing and soliciting sexually explicit images through electronic means as part of New Jersey Student Learning Standards in Comprehensive Health and Physical Education.

Bill: S847 ScasSaAca (3R) P.L. 2018, c. 73
Summary: Requires school districts to provide daily recess period for students in grade kindergarten through 5; permits denial of recess for violation of code of student conduct but student must be provided restorative justice activities.

Bill: S414 ScaAca (2R) P.L. 2018, c. 5
Summary: Requires school districts, charter schools, nonpublic schools, and contracted service providers to review employment history of prospective employees who will have regular contact with students to ascertain allegations of child abuse or sexual misconduct.
